Dear Parent / Carer,

Our School Sports Day is taking place on Wednesday 19th June 2019.

Like last year:

Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) will be in the morning - 9.30-11.30am

Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be in the afternoon - 1:30-3:15pm

All children will partake in a series of activities in a 'carousel' format, following on from these, those children who wish to, have the opportunity to be involved in a series of races. The Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 Sports Day events will both take place on the field at our Key Stage 2 Junior Site.

As usual children are divided up into houses. The houses are outlined below, as are the house colours. Your child should come to school on Wednesday 19th June wearing suitable training shoes, navy blue shorts and a T-Shirt that is their house colour. If you are unsure of your child's house / colour please see your child's class teacher or Mrs Fairfax in the school office.

Kestrels - Green

Kites - Yellow

Falcons - Blue

Eagles - Red

If your child does not have a t-shirt in the correct colour, they should wear their white PE shirt instead and they will be given a coloured sticker once they arrive at school. Children do not need to have their school uniform in with them on this day; they will remain in their sports day kit for the entire day. Please also send your child to school with a water bottle, labelled with your child's name and class (water only please), and if the weather is warm and sunny, covered in sun cream and with a hat as well!

We are hopeful that the weather next week will be dry, and that Sports Day will go ahead. If the weather is atrocious and we feel that it would be unsafe for Sports Day to take place, staff will notify you on the morning of Wednesday 19th June 2019.
