Book bags

Reading

Please listen to your child read for 10 to 15 minutes everyday as it will help develop their reading skills. When you hear your child read please sign their home record and feel free to comment on how much they have read or how they read. Encourage understanding by discussing the story or information by asking questions. Books will be changed once both books have been read and this is clearly recorded in the reading record.

Phonics

There is a strong emphasis on Phonics in Year One carrying on from the foundations laid in Reception. Phonics is fun! We play lots of games to support your child's reading, spelling and writing. At the end of the year, your child will take part in a Phonics check. We will provide further information closer to the time.

Homework

Homework will be sent home on a Friday. These are weekly spellings based on your child's phonics teaching. The spellings will be checked the following Friday in a very informal way! We also send home practical maths and English challenges relating to the week's learning. These are often interactive and ICT based and do not need to be handed in.

P.E. Days

Outdoor games is on a Tuesday afternoon with a sports coach.

Indoor P.E. days change half termly, therefore please ensure your child has a PE kit in school at all times.

P.E. kits will be sent home at the end of each half term for a good wash!

Home School Agreement

These will be sent home separately for you to read, sign and send back to school.

Communication with School

Information will be sent home via letters and emails. If you need a quick chat with one of us, feel free to grab us at the end of the day even if it is to book a longer appointment. Within the Year One team there is Mrs Cross, Mrs Tebb, Mrs Stafford and Mrs Brocklehurst who support the children's learning.

We can also communicate via Class Dojo, which you will need to sign up to at the beginning of the year (class teacher will send home information regarding the signing up process). Class teachers will only respond to messages during working hours and if we feel it is relevant to respond.
