Reading

It is **essential** that your child brings their reading books and <u>signed</u> reading records in to school with them every day. The children will be allowed to go to the library to change their reading books, as and when they need to, this is <u>their</u> responsibility.

As well as individual reading, children will also have a **guided reading session** with an adult at least once a week. Within the school, there is a huge focus on guided reading with groups of children, to ensure children are comprehending what they read.

Please support your child by encouraging them to read daily, for a minimum of 15 minutes, and signing their Reading Record on a weekly basis. Even at this stage, it is extremely helpful and beneficial if you encourage discussion about the plot, characters and what may happen in the story. Please ask your children questions about the story they are reading e.g. How does the character feel? What do you think will happen next? Why do you think that character has done that?

<u>Homework</u>

Homework for Year 3 will be given out on a <u>Friday</u>, to be handed in the following **Wednesday**. Homework needs to be completed in the purple Homework book. Homework will consist of Reading, Spellings, 1x English/Topic Homework and Maths CGP work book.
