<b>Tuesday</b>	Handwriting practise 4 - see information on website.  Spelling practise 4 - can you make a sentence for each spelling?	Create your own version of 'Countdown'. Have 10 small pieces of paper, 7 numbers are below 10. 3 numbers are: 25, 50 and 75.  Ask an adult to give you a number between 100 - 500. Can you make this number using the least amount of numbers you have in front of you? Don't forget, use addition, subtraction, multiply and divide where you need to.
