



Reception Home Learning - 20th April 2020

'The 3 Little Pigs'

	Topic	Maths - Shape and Measure	Phonics
Monday	Watch 'The 3 Little Pigs' on YouTube. Talk about the sequence of the stories and the characters. Challenge: Write a simple sentence to describe the character e.g. The wolf is bad.	Go on a shape hunt around the house. Can you find any 2D shapes? Can you find any 3D shapes? Challenge: Can you describe the items e.g. corners/sides and 2D/3D shape names?	Using the Phase 3 flashcards given out in the home learning pack, can you see which ones you can read in a simple word? Can you write words with each sound?
Tuesday	Using junk modelling items from around the house, create your own home. Challenge: Can you design your home before you build it? Can you label it?	Look at the house you have made out of junk. What shapes did you use? Why did you choose that shape? Talk to your family about the shapes in your creation Challenge: Can you name the shapes? Can you describe the 3D shapes using vertices and sides?	Using a sound that you were unsure of yesterday, ask your grown up to write words on pieces of paper using this sound. Place the words around the room on the floor and play some music. When the music stops, pick up a word and read it to your grown up. If you knew all the sounds, write words with 'sp' in.
Wednesday	Write a simple sentence about the house you created yesterday e.g. It has 4 windows. The house has a door and a roof.	Looking at your family members. Which one is the tallest? Shortest? Can you put your family members in order? Challenge: Can you put items around the house in height order?	Pictionary: Using the words from yesterday, ask your grown up to draw the word. Can you guess what it is? Can you write the word on your own?
Thursday	Choose 3 materials and make homes out of them. Which one would protect you from the wolf? Try to blow the houses down with your family. Challenge: Can you write down your prediction in a simple sentence? Were you correct?	Looking at the items in your house, can you measure them using your hands? Remember not to leave any gaps! Can you measure a window, the width of the door, the washing machine? Which one is widest? Which one is the tallest? Challenge: Can you use a tape measure to measure them?	Using another sound that you were unsure of on Monday, access Obb and Bob on PhonicsPlay. Can you read the words to your grown up? Can you put them into the correct place? If you were confident with all the sounds on Monday, look at Phase 4 'st'
Friday	Watch the alternative version of the story on YouTube 'The 3 Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig'. Discuss how this story was similar and different. Challenge: Can you draw your favourite character from this version of the story?	Draw 3 Little Pigs that are different sized or make them using play dough. Can you measure them using a tape measure? Challenge: Odd One Out - Ask an adult to place 3 objects on the table with 1 being different to the other. Which is odd? How do you know?	Play Geraldine the Giraffe using yesterday's sound. 'Off you go around the house finding something that's featuring the sound....' Can you write a list of objects with your sound?
