RE		Baptism	Recap what baptism is and what it means to you. Discuss why some people are baptised.

When you're out on a walk or in your garden, look at the trees around you. If you can, collect some leaves and look at the differences between them. Did they come from a deciduous or evergreen tree? Can you name any deciduous or evergreen trees?

Geography		Climates	Recap the names of some hot countries. Choose one of the hot countries that you remember and research 3 facts about it.
Art and DT		Making and Modelling	Watch an episode of The Clangers, available on BBC iPlayer, such as this one: https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b0956v5w/clangers. Make the small world set for the Clangers.
Computing		Coding	https://www.j2e.com/j2code/ Click on the Year 1/2 tab in top left corner and select lesson 1. Press the video button first to watch the aim of the lesson. Then click on the rocket icon which will take you to the coding game to play.
PSHE		Feelings relationships	Talk about people who are important to you. Say "(name) is my (connection) and he/she is important to me because (reason)." Discuss the different sorts of people who are important e.g. parents, family, friends, NHS etc. Explain that know that we all have different special people and for different reasons.
