Science	<u>KAI</u>	Plants	Discuss the things that a flower or plant need to survive and grow. If you can, plant your own flower or plant and look after it to make it grow. You could take a picture daily of your flower or plant so you can see the changes over time as it grows. You could even keep your own diary to write about what is happening!
History		Planets - sequencing in order of time	Make a timeline showing the order of which the planets were found. Which planet was found first? Who found the first planet?
Art and DT		Designing and constructing	A few weeks ago, you planned and designed your own rocket. Can you have a go at building one using whatever materials you have available? Be as creative as you can with what you have at home!
Computing	E C	Coding	Give somebody else in your house a list of algorithms (instructions) to make them move forwards and backwards. Can they give you some algorithms to follow? For example: Go forward 3 steps. Go backward 5 steps. Challenge: Ask the person you are playing with to change direction by turning left and right, as well as forwards and backwards. For example: Go forward 3 steps, turn right. Go forwards 5 steps, turn left. Go backwards 7 steps.

PSHE	Self-reflection	Think about what you are looking forward to about coming back to school. Draw pictures of the things that you are looking forward to, but don't tell anybody. When you've finished your pictures, show a grown up and see if they can guess what you're most looking forward to.
