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| Monday | <p><u>This week we are going to focus on shape!</u></p> <p><u>2D shape Hunt</u></p> <p>Go on a shape hunt around your house and see how many objects you can see that have 2D shapes in them.</p> <p>Remember the different 2D shapes: circle, square, oblong/rectangle, triangle, pentagon and hexagon.</p> <p>Challenge: can you talk about the similarities of the shapes you find? E.g. how many corners do all of the triangle objects have?</p> | <p><u>Handwriting!</u></p> <p>It seems like a long time ago since we asked you to do some handwriting, so that's what we're going to do today!</p> <p>Who remembers how to write in their beautiful pre cursive handwriting?</p> <p>Using the sheet called 'handwriting practice', take your time to work through it and maybe even put some music on to help you practice!</p> |
| Tuesday | <p><u>2D pictures</u></p> <p>Using only 2D shapes, can you create a picture. It could be your house or even the park.</p> <p>For example:</p> <p>Challenge: Can you label some of the shapes you have used?</p>  | <p><u>Sound hunt!</u></p> <p>Find as many objects as you can inside your house or in the garden which contain the er/ur/ir phoneme (sound). Look inside and outside. Write labels for the objects you have found.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write these words in sentences? Example: A church is bigger than a girl.</p> |

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| <p>Wednesday</p> | <p><u>Geoboard shape fun!</u></p> <p>Today we would like you to use the link below to have fun with the interactive geoboard and make as many 2D shapes as you can. Make sure you can tell somebody the name of each 2D shape that you make.</p> <p>https://apps.mathlearningcenter.org/geoboard/</p> <p>Challenge: can you create a picture using the geoboard and the 2D shapes you have learnt?</p> | <p><u>Alphabet bunting!</u></p> <p>Today we would like you to make your own 'mini' alphabet bunting. Using the pre cursive style, can you write out the alphabet and decorate each piece of bunting.</p> <p>For example:</p>  <p>Challenge: can you also write the upper case (capital) letter to go with each of your pre cursive lower case letters?</p> |
| <p>Thursday</p> | <p><u>3D shapes</u></p> <p>Today we are moving onto 3D shapes. Can you remember any?</p> <p>Using the sheet labelled '3D shape hunt', go on a hunt around your house or garden and see if you can find any objects that have 3D shapes in them.</p> <p>Make sure you use the vocabulary box at the bottom of the sheet to help you remember the names of the shapes and how to spell them.</p> | <p><u>Letter to a loved one</u></p> <p>Using all the handwriting practice you have done, today we would like you to write a letter to someone you don't live with. This could be grandparents, a cousin or even a friend.</p> <p>If you are going to post the letter, can you help to write their name and address on the front?</p> |
