Phonics

Our sound this week is 'd' Watch Geraldine the Giraffe on Mr Thorne does phonics and look for objects at home beginning with this sound.

Phonics game

This week we are going to play 'Please Mr Crocodile can I cross the river?' You will need a piece of blue cloth (the river) and 6 objects to sound out eg c-a-p. One person can be the crocodile and the other person has to say "Mr Crocodile can I cross the river?" Mr Crocodile says "Yes, if you bring me a c-a-p". The other person has to choose the correct object in order to cross the river. Change around so that the other person can be the crocodile.

Maths

You could also have a look at different farm animals, how many legs do they all have? For example cow, sheep, goat, chicken, pig, duck. You could use pictures or animal toys to help you. How many legs would there be altogether if there were 2 ducks, cows etc?
