A year Four Linguist

Year 4 continue to consolidate their knowledge of numbers, alphabet, colours etc. They also learn how to say what foods they like; to talk about the weather; to say how they get to school; about animals and the Carnival of the Animals; about favourite sports and Le Tour de France. In addition they continue using the bilingual dictionary.

Year 4 expectations:

- I can have a short conversation in French.
- I can listen out for certain words in a song or story.
- I know numbers to 31.
- I can say some common phonemes.
- I can write some words in French from memory.
- I can copy phrases in French.
- I can read and understand simple sentences eg about the weather.
- I can make simple sentences using a model, including adjectives.
- I can reorder jumbled sentences.
- I understand about gender in French and I know there are 3 ways to say 'my' in French.
- I can use the conjunction et=and.
- I know some familiar verbs.
