

Corporate Funding Report

October 2021 PTA AGM

At last year's AGM, I was pleased to take on the new committee role of Corporate Funding Officer. This role was created to explore external funding sources for the school, for the benefit of the children.

My aims in this role are to:

- 1. Source and apply for grants on behalf of the PTA
- 2. Identify initiatives that would benefit the school, and
- 3. Seek donations for the benefit of the children.

Despite the challenges brought about by the pandemic, we have received many wonderful grants and donations through corporate funding this year, and I am pleased to share a summary of our achievements since the last AGM in October 2020.

Grants and donations received

- In October 2020, Asda Reddish donated 100 activity books to the school.
- In November 2020, the PTA received a grant of £1000 from the Asda Foundation for the purchase of stationery, PPE, and games for the breakfast and after school clubs.
- In January 2021, Asda Reddish donated drinks and snacks to the school, for the children of keyworkers at Infants.
- In February 2021:
 - Asda Reddish donated bread making ingredients for all children of keyworkers at Infants
 - Speaking Volumes granted the school £250 to purchase books on Christianity.
- In March 2021:
 - o The Siobhan Dowd Trust granted the school £300 to spend on library books.
 - The PTA received a payment of £398.55 from the Co-op Local Community Fund, for the Outdoor Reflection Area.
- In April 2021:
 - Morrisons Reddish donated sunflower seeds and a small selection of gardening equipment to the school, as part of their Seeds of Hope campaign.
 - B&Q Handforth donated £605 worth of paint to the PTA, as part of their community reuse scheme.
- In May 2021, Asda Reddish donated a large selection of goodies to the PTA to be used as prizes for the luxury raffle.
- In June 2021:
 - The PTA received a grant of £1000 from Arnold Clark to spend on iPads or laptops.
 - The school received a donation of spring bulbs from Bulbs4Kids.
- In September 2021, the PTA received a grant of £200 from the Asda Foundation for our participation in the Asda Green Token scheme, which will to go towards creating a school vegetable garden at Infants.
- In October 2021, The Tree Council granted the PTA an orchard tree pack, comprising 5
 maiden fruit trees.
