Appointments will be held between parents and staff whilst your child will sit with the teaching assistant to complete some activities

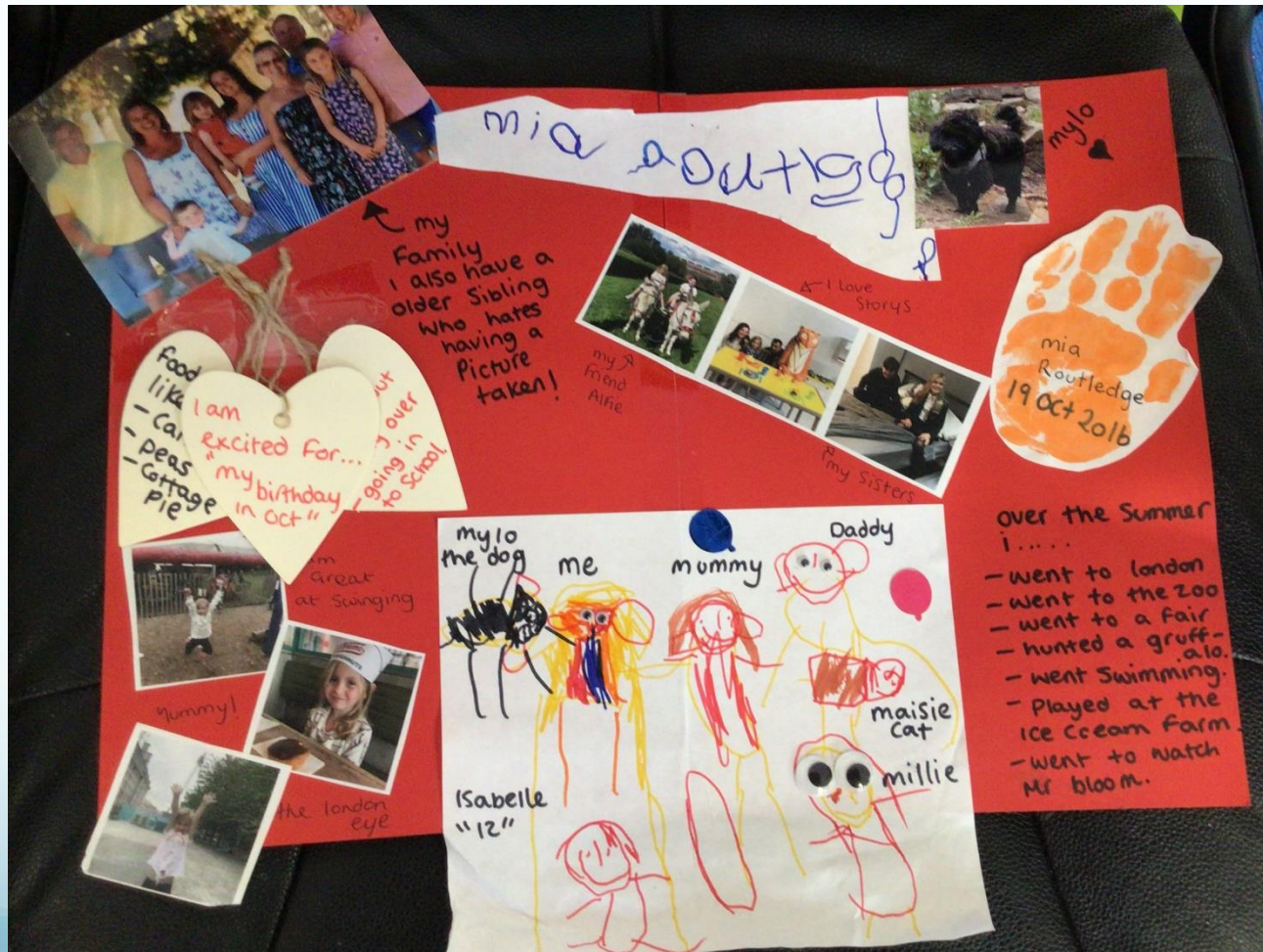
Appointments will only last 25 minutes so please bring any questions or useful information with you for your meeting
